Medication Assisted Treatment



Background

Opioids were involved in more than 68,000 deaths in 2020 in the US, which was 8.5 times the number of opioid-involved overdose deaths in 1999. This number has been increasing due to the rise of synthetic opioids most commonly fentanyl. This exemplifies the need for medication assisted treatment (MAT) clinics with a patient-centered approach incorporating medication treatment with counseling and behavior therapy.



About the Program

NOVA ScriptsCentral partnered with Mason and Partners (MAP) to create a MAT Program to promote, coordinate, and support opioid addiction treatment in an outpatient setting. It provides buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone) medication, Vivitrol, and Sublocade to patients with opioid use disorder (OUD) in a community clinic. The MAT Clinic focuses on eliminating barriers to accessing treatment for OUD by following a harm reduction model of care.

The MAT clinic serves adolescent, adult, and senior patients with opioid use disorder (OUD) at no cost for clinic services for both those insured and uninsured. Referrals come from anywhere. The MAT clinic works closely with Prince William County for those with criminal justice involvement.
